

## Response to Parliamentary Committees and External Audits

### Response to parliamentary committees

On May 6, 2015, the Standing Senate Committee on National Finance has done an examination of the [Main Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2016](#), of the National Film Board of Canada. The NFB presented its [Report on the Main Estimates for 2015-2016](#) which include an overview of its commercial activities, its financial pressures and the impact of the relocation of its headquarters on its budget. No recommendation has been received from the Committee.

### Response to the Auditor General

No responses to the Auditor General were requested in 2015–16.

### Response to external audits conducted by the Public Service Commission of Canada or the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages

#### **OCOL Report Card**

The Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages conducted an audit on the implementation of the Official Languages Act within the NFB. Started in spring 2015, the audit was still ongoing as of March 31, 2016.

#### **Verification by the Canadian Human Rights Commission (CHRC) on the Employment Equity**

The NFB has been under an audit by the CHRC for its compliance in the application of the Employment Equity Act. Begun in 2015, the audit was still ongoing at 31 March 2016. The NFB has implemented the recommendations of the draft audit report, including the development of an action plan on equity ' employment.
